

- 1. Fill tank with water to max (5ltr)
 And attach hose
- 2. Plug into mains allow water to heat for 15-20 mins Once heated use device for wallpaper stripping
- 3. After 80 mins unplug
- 4. Allow to cool for 2 mins before undoing tank cap, then refill with water Repeat steps 2-3 as needed

Safety

Protect yourself

Wear heat-resistant gloves, a dust mask, and eye protection. If you're working on a ceiling, also wear a hat and long-sleeved clothing.

Protect your surroundings

Cover any light switches and sockets, and open windows to prevent steam from causing problems. If you're working near electrical fixtures, turn off the power at the mains.

Be careful with the steam

Never point the hose or steam plate at anyone. Keep the steam plate tilted away from your face and body. Regularly empty condensation from the plate, especially when working on ceilings or high areas.

Handle with care

Don't handle the mains plug or water tank with wet hands. Allow the steam plates and hose to cool down before changing them.

Don't put the wrong things in the water tank

Never put descaling, aromatic, alcoholic, or detergent products into the water tank.
